





Corporate Resource Centre (CRC) PLACEMENT POWERHOUSE

The Corporate Resource Centre, or Placement Cell, is crucial in bridging the gap between academia and industry by offering career counseling, need-based education, and organizational support. CRC organizes campus interviews for student placements and training, along with corporate guest lectures and industry interactions.

As a central interface between students, faculty, and the corporate world, CRC fosters continuous engagement with the industry by sharing experiences and understanding corporate needs. Regularly, CRC invites leaders from top companies to campus to share insights on current economic issues, enriching the intellectual environment at IMS.

Our course curriculum is complemented by a placement strategy that introduces students to corporate culture. Under IMS CRC's guidance, various management events help shape students' personal and professional development to align with corporate expectations. CRC broadly manages placement activities, encompassing pre-placement preparedness, live projects, summer internships, corporate guest talks, and final placements. The Institute has consistently maintained a strong placement record since its inception.

Selection Procedure

Organizations are encouraged to confirm participation in the Campus Placement Programme in advance. They may request the Institute to send student resumés as per their needs or provide a list of candidates for interview. The Institute ensures that all arrangements meet the visiting company's requirements.

This program allows the corporate world to engage with prospective recruits, both for two-month projects and final placements. During corporate presentations, students gain insights into job descriptions, compensation, growth prospects, and cross-functional opportunities.

Many organizations also conduct written tests as part of the selection process, which the Institute facilitates during their campus visit for pre-placement talks.

Summer Internship

The 8-week Summer Project is an essential component of the PGDM curriculum, valued for its practical relevance. CRC assists in identifying suitable project opportunities across various organizations. Companies collaborate with IMS faculty and the CRC team to outline project expectations. Once allocated a project, students are required to accept their first offer. As part of their project work, students submit a report, and their presentation to the organization forms the basis of the Summer Project evaluation.
